#### **7. Brief characteristic of BEP:**

##### 7.1. Educational aims of the program:

The program aims to furnish students with advanced skills suitable for scientific researches and legal practice in different governmental structures, commercial companies, advocacy, notaries, universities and human rights organizations.

##### 7.2. Area, objects and types of professional bachelors' activities:

The program includes activity in next fields:

- development and implementation of legal standards;
- ensuring the rule of law;
- legal education and training.

Objects of professional activity are public relations in the implementation of legal norms, ensuring the rule of law and order.

During the program bachelor gains skills which make him able to work in next types of activity:

- a) legislation;
- b) enforcement;
- c) law-enforcement;
- d) expert consulting;
- e) pedagogical.

### 7.3. Period of studying:

- internal form – 4 years;
- internally-correspondence form - 4 years;
- correspondence form – 5 years;
- correspondence form in short terms – 4 years.

7.4. General number of credit hours – 240. During this time students will have all types of classroom/self-study, practice and control of quality.

### **8. Competitive advantages of graduates:**

Graduates of Basic Educational Program have high quality of education. During the program they get not just fundamental theoretical knowledge, but also practical skills. So, graduates have opportunity either to start working after finishing the program or to continue education as Master, Postgraduate and Doctoral student.

### **9. Institute facilities.**

Law Institute of SFU has its own separate educational building. In the institute there are 49 classrooms, the square of the building is 3744,1 m<sup>2</sup>, which includes 14 lecture rooms ( for 140 students in common), 1 interactive auditorium, 1 courtroom, 3 language laboratories, 3 computer class for students.

In 76 % of classrooms are equipped with presentation and computer facilities, in particular: 114 computers, 37 units for presentation (with interactive desks, desks of rear projection, projectors, plasmas). Each computer has an access to the Internet and possibility of use electronic law resources and library resources. Speed of Internet connection is until 100 mb/sec. Traffic is unlimited. Also, educational process in Law Institute is organized with use of classrooms, equipment, and other sources of SFU.

On the ground floor of a Law Institute building there is a dining room of SFU' s combine (the square is 199,3 m<sup>2</sup>). The assortment of dishes here is different , the quality of dishes is high, the average price for the complex dinner is 3-4 times less than the average price of the same dishes in other canteens of Krasnoyarsk.

Sport facilities are provided on 3 areas:

1) in the Sport centre of SFU there is a stadium with a football pitch, street thainers, obstacle course, sport halls, training halls, a skiing slope. The common square of the sport complex is 1380 m<sup>2</sup>, and the square of equipment areas are 8500 m<sup>2</sup>

2) there are 2 leased sport centers with a field and a track and gyms( this is next to Law Institute within of 2 or 10 minutes walk). The overall area is 1390 m<sup>2</sup>

In SFU there is a computer-based library. In Law Institute building there is a scientific subscription and an electronic reading room for 10 places. Common quantity of access units to the electronic library in the building is 124 places.

There are informative and law databases such as Garant, Consultant Plus, Codex.

There are domestic databases like Integrum, EastView, LH of RSL dissertations. eLibrary, PH « Grebennikova», Antology of Russian civil law.

There are foreign databases such as Blackwell, Jstor, Project Muse, EBSCO Publishing, Catalog AtoZ (EBSCO Publishing), Freedom Collection, Cambridge Journals, Oxford Journals, Springer – Kluwer, Sage Publishing, World Scientific, Sage Publications, Taylor&Francis, Annual Reviews, Oxford Handbooks On-line.

## **10. Program structures:**

B1. Humanitarian, Social and Economical Cycle: This cycle includes Philosophy, Foreign language in jurisprudence, Economics, Life Safety.

B2. Legal information Cycle: This cycle presented by discipline Informational Technology in legal activity.

B3. Professional Cycle: Professional Cycle includes Theory of State and Law, Legal and State History of foreign countries, Constitutional Law, Administrative Law, Civil Law, Civil process, Arbitrage process, Labor Law, Criminal Law, Criminal process, Ecological Law, Land Law, Financial Law, Tax Law, Business Law, International Law, Private International Law, Criminalistics, Social Security Law.
